Helenekilde Badehotel

Often called the Danish Hamptons, the seaside resort of Tisvildeleje is just an hour north of the capital, and historically where Copenhageners have come to seek refuge from the hustle and bustle of city life each summer. Now the in-the-know place to stay for natives and internationals alike, it's also where you'll find the family-run Helenekilde Badehotel. Translated as 'hotel facing the sea', it was originally built as a private home in 1896 before being converted to a boarding house at the turn of the 20th century.

Set a short walk from both the beach and forest that surrounds it, as well as an abundance of must-visit shops, bistros and a weekly market, Helenekilde Badehotel oozes pared-back Scandi charm. Filled with rattan furniture, jute carpeting and thick linens, there are just 27 rooms, all featuring either a balcony or a terrace. There are also two on-site restaurants too, serving delicious rustic dishes and freshly caught fish. Who wouldn't want to watch the sun set over the Kattegat Sea, chilled glass of wine in hand? Prices start at €350 for a two-night stay.
